The Gwich'in Nation has lost a light, leader, mother, wife, relative, friend, and colleague. Deputy Grand Chief McLeod embodied the values of YIINJINIHŁETR'ICHIL'EH (Respect), CHIGWIJUU'EE TR'IGWINDAII (Honesty), YIINJITR'ICHIL'EH (Honor), TR'EEDLAA (Laughter), ZHUH GHAT T'IGWIDICH'UU (Kindness), and NIHK'ATR'INAATII (Sharing & Caring). She was proud to be Gwich'in, she supported and enabled those around her, and she inspired people to think differently about leadership, politics, and everyone's role in creating a better future.

We witnessed the impact of Deputy Grand Chief McLeod through her words and actions. She actively listened and engaged, questioned and laughed, reported out and shared, and was dedicated to advancing the interests of the Gwich'in Nation. She supported our work, particularly related to empowering youth and building opportunities for their involvement and leadership. Her participation at GCI events in Inuvik, NT and virtually raised awareness and pride, and contributed to strong and meaningful engagement and outcomes.

Our hearts are heavy as we mourn the loss of GTC Deputy Grand Chief Kristine McLeod.

"Our Nation has lost a beautiful leader. We will never forget the kindness and love she had for us all. May her strength, passion, integrity and vision continue within each of us," says Gwich'in Council International Board member Sharla Greenland.
